



## SELECTED WORKS BY JOANNA BRAITHWAITE

Joanna Braithwaite's paintings of animals and humans have established her reputation as an artist concerned with the natural world, evolution and science, and the nature of authority and power.

Born in the United Kingdom, Braithwaite's family moved to New Zealand when she was a child. She graduated from the University of Canterbury School of Fine Arts, Christchurch, in 1984. Moving between New Zealand and Australia in the 1990s, she completed postgraduate study at the College of Fine Arts in Sydney, where she now resides.

Braithwaite grew up in a rural farming community and maintains that underpinning her practice is a curiosity in relationships people have with animals. Her paintings explore this theme in a multitude of ways including strange juxtapositions and role reversal and often contain elements of humour as a way of engaging the viewer.

Since the 1980s, Braithwaite has regularly presented solo exhibitions in Australia and New Zealand. Her work was the subject of a major survey exhibition curated by the Christchurch and Dunedin public art galleries in 2005. Braithwaite has been included in group exhibitions in public institutions including Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery, Hazelhurst Regional Gallery & Arts Centre, Hawkesbury Regional Gallery, Tweed River Art Gallery, and Mosman Art Gallery. She is a multiple finalist in the Archibald Prize at the Art Gallery of New South Wales, most recently in 2022 with her portrait of Sally McManus. In 2019 Braithwaite was the winner of the Ravenswood Australian Women's Art Prize.

Braithwaite's works are held in public collections including Christchurch Art Gallery, Macquarie University, and Tweed River Art Gallery.
