
With a practice traversing an array of media, celebrated Sydney-based artist Noel McKenna poetically and humorously depicts everyday scenes, people, animals and objects. An observer of daily life and suburban culture, the construction of McKenna's works engagingly hint at a story beyond the picture plane. The narrative may be as varied as suburban life is in Australia, however McKenna's drawings, prints, sculpture, painting and ceramic ware are created with a central purpose: to create art that provides a set of everyday images and ideas that make us question our own sense of self.

McKenna's compositions often highlight a point of vulnerability - a lone subject lost in their own thoughts, or suburban exteriors seemingly detached from their surroundings. However McKenna's works are unified by tenderness and quiet humour; a subtly emotive visual language. His use of minimal shapes reveals a simplistic beauty in our everyday life and the world captured by McKenna is effortlessly likeable. In this sense, these works do a lot with a little.

McKenna is represented by a handful of high-end galleries and over the last 30 years, he has staged a number of solo exhibitions at leading Australian art museums such as the Queensland Art Gallery | Gallery of Modern Art, Brisbane and the National Art School Gallery, Sydney; as well as international shows in London, New York, Dublin, Hong Kong and Auckland. The artist has also participated in group exhibitions and fairs at institutions such as the Museum of Contemporary Art Australia, Art Gallery of New South Wales, Art Basel Miami and his works are included in the collection of both eminent museums and private collectors.

McKenna is a regular finalist for major art prizes - he has been a finalist in the 2021 Dobell Drawing Prize and has previously been awarded the Sulman and Wynne Prizes, as well as the Mosman Prize.
